Management Plan Update

The Elfin Forest Management Plan represents a unique collaboration among a community based organization, SLO County Parks, and CA Dept. of Parks and Recreation. A "user's guide" to the Elfin Forest, the management plan will define access, allowable uses, and long-term operating policies. We are planning to hold an open meeting early this winter for public comment.

Taking A First Step

Pete Waldburger has collected seeds from pygmy oaks, manzanitas and bush lupines in the Elfin Forest. These seeds will be germinated to provide plants for revegetation efforts.

SLO Environmental Grant

SWAP has received a \$225 grant from SLO County Environmental Funds to cover the cost of materials for a bench and viewing platform at Bush Lupine overlook. Actual construction will take place after approval of the management plan.
